Minutes from the February 07, 2019 City Council Meeting

**City Hall
Council Chamber
February 7, 2019**

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Council was held in the Council Chambers of the Dublin City Hall on Thursday, February 7, 2019 at 12:30 P.M.

Mayor Phil Best called the meeting to order. Council members Bill Brown, Bennie Jones, Gerald Smith, Curtis Edwards, and Jerry Davis were present. Councilman Paul Griggs and Gary Johnson were absent. Councilman Smith gave the invocation followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

APPROVAL OF THE JANUARY 17, 2019 CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

A motion was made by Councilman Jones and seconded by Councilman Davis to approve the minutes. The motion carried 5/0.

APPROVAL OF BILLS OVER \$3000

A motion was made by Councilman Edwards and was seconded by Councilman Jones to approve the following bills. The motion carried 5/0.

APPROVAL OF PURCHASES OVER \$3,000

City Manager Jones explained that there was one purchase for Council consideration for the Telecommunications department. The “GigaCenters” will deliver broadband internet over WIFI and ethernet to the business customers and will replace some of the older units and will be used for new clients. Staff’s recommendation was to award Calix the contract in the amount of \$7559.62. Councilman Brown made a motion to approve the contract and seconded by Councilman Smith. The motion carried 5/0.

FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE 1.48 ACRES LOCATED AT 519 SMITH STREET FROM R-3 (MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL) ZONE TO R-5 (HIGH DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT) ZONE.

City Manager Jones read the ordinance to rezone 519 Smith Street from R-3 zone to R-5 zone. Mayor Best stated that the Second Reading/Public Hearing will be held at the next regular meeting on February 21, 2019.
