

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for U.S. Hwy. 80 Gas Main Extension, Dublin, Georgia are solicited as described below.

WORK DESCRIPTION:

The Work generally consists of the construction of a 2-inch steel high-pressure natural gas main and a 4-inch polyethylene natural gas main in East Dublin, GA. Construction activities include the installation of approximately 6,050 linear feet of 2-inch steel natural gas main, 13,525 linear feet of 4-inch polyethylene natural gas main, a pressure regulator station, six line-valves, other related construction and appurtenances.

RECEIPT OF BIDS:

Bids (including the completed Bid Form and all required documents) must be received at the office of the Owner at or before 2:00 P.M. prevailing local time on October 8, 2019. **Bids must be sealed** and marked **U.S. Hwy. 80 Gas Main Extension**. Bids will be opened at 2:00 P.M. on October 8, 2019 at City Hall, 100 South Church Street, Dublin, GA 31021.

BIDDING DOCUMENTS:

The Bidding Documents (consisting of the Project Manual and Drawings) may be examined at the offices of the Owner and Engineer at the addresses given above. To assure that Bidders receive all addenda and clarifications to the Bidding Documents, it is mandatory that Bidders contact the Engineer directly to obtain the Bidding Documents. A set of Bidding Documents may be obtained at the office of Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc., the Engineer, upon receipt of a check for \$100 made payable to the City of Dublin.

BIDDER'S QUALIFICATIONS:

All Bidders must submit, with the Bid, written evidence of Bidder's qualifications to perform the Work covered by the Contract Documents, and other documentation called for in Article 3 of the Instructions to Bidders. No Bid will be considered unless it is accompanied by satisfactory evidence that the Bidder holds Georgia State Contractor's License of proper classification and in full force and effect, in compliance with Act. O.C.G.A. 43-14. In compliance with Subpart N, Qualification of Pipeline Personnel, of Pipeline Safety Regulations Part 192 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, prior to performing covered tasks on the Owner's facilities, the Successful

Bidder must demonstrate to the Owner that individuals who will be performing covered tasks are qualified pursuant to the Owner's written Operator Qualification Program.

HEALTH AND SAFETY:

The Successful Bidder shall protect the health and monitor the safety of its personnel, subcontractors, and other persons who may be affected by the Work and the environment. Throughout the full duration of the Work, the Successful Bidder shall comply with the Pipeline Safety Regulations Part 192 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations and all applicable federal, state, and local regulations, and all applicable requirements of the Owner.

BID SECURITY:

Bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the Bidder's Base Bid Price must accompany each Bid in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.

AWARD, WAIVER AND REJECTION OF BIDS:

Bid shall remain valid and shall not be subject to withdrawal for a period of 60 calendar days after the Bid opening, except as provided in the Instructions to Bidders. A single Bid shall be submitted for all portions of the Work. The contract will be awarded pursuant to the requirements of applicable state and federal laws and regulations. To the extent permitted by such laws and regulations, Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informality or irregularity in any Bid received, and to accept the Bid deemed by it to be the most advantageous to its interests.

PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS:

Upon award of the contract, the Successful Bidder shall execute separate "Performance" and "Payment" Bonds using the forms contained in the Bidding Documents, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price. The bonds shall be delivered to the Engineer when the Contractor delivers the executed Agreement in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
