

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, TO AMEND ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 20 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR DRIVEWAY AND ENCROACHMENT CONTROL UPON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dublin, Georgia have been vested with substantial powers, rights, and functions to generally regulate the usage of land within the City for the purposes of maintaining health, safety, morals, and general welfare pursuant to the Georgia Constitution, Art. IX, Sec. 2, Par. IV; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dublin, Georgia have been specifically vested with substantial powers, rights, and functions to generally regulate the usage of the public streets within the corporate limits of the City of Dublin, Georgia pursuant to Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE:

There is now added a new Section 20-4 to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Dublin within Chapter 20, "Streets and Sidewalks", Article I, "In General", to read as follows:

"Prior to the construction of any driveway or other encroachment upon the right of way to any public street within the corporate limits of the City of Dublin, Georgia, a permit for the same shall be obtained from the City of Dublin engineering department. The applicant shall submit an application on a form developed and approved by the City Engineer and shall pay an application fee in an amount set by the City Engineer with the approval of the City Manager. The specifications for any and all driveways and encroachments upon the right of way or public streets within the corporate limits of the City of Dublin shall meet, at a minimum, the standard specifications set by the Georgia Department of Transportation, and any other specifications required by the City Engineer, or his/her designee, as may be dictated by the location of the proposed driveway or encroachment."

SECTION TWO:

This ordinance shall become effective at 12:00 noon on the fifth day after its adoption.
