

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO ADD A NEW SECTION 24-24 TO ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 24, UTILITIES, TO PROVIDE FOR AND AUTHORIZE SEPARATE WRITTEN AGREEMENTS REGARDING THE PROVISION OF UTILITY SERVICES; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, is hereby amended by added a section to be numbered 24-24, to Article 1 of Chapter 24 of this Code, which shall read as follows:

“Notwithstanding the provisions of this Chapter to the contrary, the Mayor and Council may, by separate written agreement, provide for any utility service of the City to any other government or government agency, industrial customer, or other heavy utility user under such terms and conditions as the mayor and council may find in the best interest of the city and as may be allowed by law.”

THIS ORDINANCE shall be effective on the at noon on the fifth day after its adoption.
