A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE DOWNTOWN DUBLIN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (DDA) TO UTILIZE A PORTION OF DOWNTOWN DUBLIN FOR A SPECIAL EVENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CARRYING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN A DESIGNATED PORTION OF DOWNTOWN; TO AUTHORIZE LICENSED RESTAURANTS TO SELL ALCOHOL BY THE DRINK WITHIN THE DESIGNATED AREA FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE ANY OTHER PERMITS NEEDED FOR THE EVENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council is vested with the authority to regulate the use of alcohol on city property;

WHEREAS, the DDA has requested the City to approve a special event for the downtown Dublin area for a Bon Temps Crawfish Festival;

WHEREAS, the DDA has secured authorization from the Georgia Department of Transportation for the closure of a portion of West Jackson Street for the Special Event;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the DDA is authorized to hold a special event throughout that portion of West Jackson Street from Monroe Street to its intersection with Jefferson Street during the hours of 8:00AM until 11:00PM on May 11, 2019. The DDA shall be responsible to ensure enough security is provided and the designated areas for the Special Event are roped off or otherwise clearly marked. Attendees of the event may carry alcoholic beverages throughout the designated area only during the special event hours authorized herein and may only carry alcoholic beverages in clear plastic cups. Restaurants with entrances within the designated area for this special event may set up and sell by the drink alcoholic beverages outside of their respective places of business but within the designated area for this event.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to approve and authorize any other local permit needed to carry out the purposes of this Resolution or required by the State.
