2019 CITY OF DUBLIN SCHOOL DISTRICT FINAL TAX MILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Dublin, Georgia, authorizes the body to assess and levy and collect ad valorem taxes on all property, real and personal, within the corporate limits of said City, and upon all goods, chattels, monies and choses in action where the owner resides within the corporate limits of said City, which are subject to taxation by the laws of this State, and upon banking, insurance, and other capital employed therein and upon any and all other things not mentioned herein upon which ad valorem taxes are usually paid; and

WHEREAS, the Dublin City School Board of Education has made a final report and recommendation to this body as required by State Law; and

WHEREAS, this report was based upon the final 2019 Laurens County Tax Digest; and

WHEREAS, a motion was adopted by the City of Dublin School District on *September 9th, 2019*, providing that such tax be assessed, levied and collected sufficient in the amount to be used for the support and maintenance of the public schools of the City of Dublin School District; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED based on the foregoing, by this body that the final ad valorem tax millage assessed, levied and collected for the City of Dublin School District for the fiscal year **2019-2020**, be as follows, to wit:

An ad valorem tax of **19.705** mills for the support of the City of Dublin School District for support and maintenance of the City of Dublin School District on all property, real and personal within the corporate limits of said City, which are subject to taxation by the laws of the State; and upon banking, insurance and other capital employed therein and upon any and all things not mentioned herein upon which ad valorem taxes are usually paid.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any Ordinance or Resolution or motions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby amended.

THIS RESOLUTION so adopted at the meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Dublin, Georgia on this the *3rd* day of *October, 2019* by a vote of **(4)** FOR and **(0)** AGAINST.
