A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO AUTHORIZE AND APPROVE THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE ONE GEORGIA AUTHORITY EQUITY FUND FOR FUNDING FOR SEWER EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT FOR INCREASED CAPACITY AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin provides sanitary sewer services for residential, business, and industrial customers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to improve and expand the sanitary sewer capacity to ensure continued ability to services said customers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has identified the existing sewer line in the US Highway 441 and State Route 257 corridors which is in need of increased capacity and expansion; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin intends to make the needed expansion and improvements to said sanitary sewer line (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the One Georgia Authority has a funding opportunity through its Equity Fund for infrastructure improvements and development such as the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin, as a Georgia Municipality, is a local government which is eligible for applying for said funding; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the City of Dublin to secure funding through the One Georgia Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN that the Mayor, City Manager, City Clerk, City Attorney, and other employees and representatives of the City are authorized to execute and deliver all documents required or deemed appropriate by them to the One Georgia Authority for funding of the Project.
