

**RESOLUTION
#20-04**

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO CHANGE THE NAME OF GRADY STREET, WHICH RUNS FROM TELFAIR STREET TO SMITH STREET, TO THE NAME OF SAMUEL MOORE, SR., STREET; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are vested with the right to manage and otherwise control the public streets within the corporate limits of the City of Dublin, Georgia pursuant to O.C.G.A. §32-4-90 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, Saxon Street School was damaged by fire caused by a 10-year old in the year 1975; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Samuel Moore, Sr., drove a bus for the school system at the time of the fire; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Samuel Moore, Sr., saw the principal of the school, Ms. Eula Jackson, attempting to escape the blaze of the fire through a window of the school; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Samuel Moore, Sr., rushed to aid Ms. Jackson and helped her escape from the fire; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it appropriate to honor and commemorate the heroic acts of Mr. Samuel Moore, Sr., for his efforts in 1975; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to re-name Grady Street which runs from Telfair Street to Smith Street, to the name of Samuel Moore, Sr., Street.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED that Grady Street as it currently exists from Telfair Street to Smith Street is hereafter named Samuel Moore, Sr., Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall have immediate effect upon its adoption.


