

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL, APPOINTING A CITY CLERK AND ELECTION SUPERINTENDENT; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Dublin, Georgia provides that the Mayor and Council shall appoint a city clerk; and

WHEREAS, historically the office of city clerk and city treasurer have been filled by one person; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council now find it necessary, appropriate, and in the best interest of the City to divide the duties of the city clerk and city treasurer between two individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire for R. Blake Daniels to continue as city treasurer as he has previously been appointed by Resolution No. 18-12; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire for the city clerk to serve as the election superintendent for all municipal elections for the city.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED that Heather Browning is hereby appointed as City Clerk and Election Superintendent for the City of Dublin, Georgia, and shall discharge all of the duties and responsibilities of those offices in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Dublin and the laws of this state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Contract of Employment Conditions attached hereto is hereby adopted and the terms therein accepted by the Mayor and Council and the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute and deliver the same on behalf the City.


THEREFORE, NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointments made herein shall become effective and commence on April 16, 2021.
