

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH A BANNER COMMITTEE; TO AUTHORIZE THE BANNER COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF BANNERS FOR DISPLAY THROUGHOUT THE CITY; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has a rich history of citizens who were instrumental in the promotion of the African American community; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to commemorate the actions and contributions of said citizens by displaying banners during appropriate times of year in their honor; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to establish a program that provides for a procedure for the nomination and approval of honorees; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to appoint a committee of council that will establish the program and administer the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL that there is established a banner committee to address the replacement of black history banners that are periodically displayed throughout the city; that the committee members shall serve for one year terms; that the initial committee members be Councilmember Bennie Jones; Councilmember Chris Smith; Artiffany Stanley; Rebecca Johnson; Miriam Lewis; and City Manager Lance Jones; and that the committee members shall hereafter be appointed by the mayor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said committee is hereby authorized to establish a procedure and set application fees and other costs associated with the display of new banners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said committee shall cause a copy of any application form, procedure, and schedule of fees to be available in the city clerk's office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall have immediate effect.
