

DIG SAFELY

- If you plan to dig or move, call 1-800-282-7411 at least two days before digging so the Utilities Protection Center (UPC) can mark underground utility lines.
- If you do not call and you hit an underground line, you could be hurt or killed. You may also be held liable for costly damages.

DIG SAFELY

- **Here are some simple excavation safety steps:**
- **Survey and Mark** – Survey proposed excavation areas and mark the dig sites in white
- **Call Before You Dig** – It is the law! At least two working days prior to starting work – 1-800-282-7411
- **Wait the Required Time** – Allow the UPC the time to locate and mark the lines
- **Respect the Marks** – Maintain visibility of the marks and safely follow them when digging
- **Dig with Care** – Hand excavate within 24-inches of each side of the lines

DIG SAFELY

If Your Equipment Contacts a Gas Line:

- **Leave equipment;** don't turn off engines or generators
- **Warn others and leave** the area quickly
- **Do not operate** any gas pipeline valves or stop the flow of gas
- Leave the **excavation open**
