Gas Main Extension to Griffin Industries

Separate sealed Bids for the construction of new 4-inch steel, high-pressure, natural gas main and other related facilities to serve Griffin Industries, will be received by the City of Dublin at City Hall located at 100 South Church Street, Dublin, Georgia until **4:00 P.M. local time, March 11, 2010**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Construction activities for this project generally includes the installation of approximately 18,000 linear feet of 4-inch steel natural gas main, line valves, a pressure regulating and metering station, and other appurtenances. The natural gas main extension will be constructed along multiple public roads in East Dublin, Georgia, beginning at the intersection of S.R. 199 and Nathaniel Drive and ending at Griffin Industries. The project includes two railroad crossings, three state route crossings and five creek crossings to be installed by directional drilling methods.

No proposal will be considered unless it is accompanied by satisfactory evidence that the Bidder holds Georgia State Contractor's License of proper classification and in full force and effect, in compliance with Act. O.C.G.A. 43-14. Contractor must be a qualified natural gas contractor under the laws of the State of Georgia and must comply with any Federal, State, and City guidelines and regulations.
