



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO OUR CUSTOMERS

KINDLY REVIEW THE FOLLOWING NOTICE IF YOU ARE A NATURAL GAS CUSTOMER WITH THE CITY OF DUBLIN.

Federal Regulation 192.16 requires that we notify you to exercise diligence regarding underground or buried gas piping. Buried pipe may be subject to leakage and/or corrosion (corrosion may occur on metallic pipe) and could be subject to hazards if not maintained.

It's important to note that as a gas consumer, you are responsible for any gas pipe downstream of the gas meter on the side of your house. This means you are accountable for maintaining and operating this part of the fuel line system. We, as the gas provider, do not own or routinely maintain the gas line beyond the gas meter. In case of any issues with the gas fuel lines or appliances, it is advisable to contact qualified and licensed commercial plumbers or heating contractors for assistance.

It is important to conduct regular inspections for leaks in buried gas piping. Additionally, if the piping is metallic, it should also be periodically inspected for corrosion. Any identified issues must be promptly repaired, and if necessary, the gas flow should be shut off. Moreover, when excavation is planned near the buried gas piping, it must be located and marked in advance, and any excavation carried out near the pipe should be done manually.
