**ORDINANCE
26-02**

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY DELETING SECTION 12-127 (“FIRE SAFETY”) OF ARTICLE V, OF CHAPTER 12, IN ITS ENTIRETY AND INSERTING A NEW SECTION 12-127 ENTITLED “FIRE SAFETY FOR MOBILE FOOD SERVICE” IN LIEU THEREOF; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE AN ADOPTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Article IX, Section II, Paragraph II of the Constitution of the State of Georgia provides that matters pertaining to municipalities may be dealt with without necessity of action by the General Assembly;

WHEREAS, the Georgia legislature passed the Municipal Home Rule Act of 1965, codified under O.C.G.A. § 36-35-1, et seq., authorizing municipal governments to adopt clearly reasonable ordinances, resolutions, or regulations for which no provision has been made by general law;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are vested with the authority to regulate rules and regulations regarding fire protection and prevention within the limits of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to amend the fire protection and prevention rules and regulations to mobile food service.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That the City of Dublin, Georgia Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting in its entirety Section 12-127 – Fire Safety, of Article V, titled Mobile Food Service, and located within Chapter 12, and inserting a new Section 12-127, which reads as follows:

“Sec. 12-127. – Fire Safety for Mobile Food Service.

All mobile food service units subject to an occupation tax certificate issued by the City shall be inspected by the Fire Inspector annually and shall be in compliance with all applicable fire codes adopted by the City of Dublin to operate within the city limits of Dublin”

SECTION 2.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective at 12:00 noon on the fifth day after its adoption.
