AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA TO AMEND SECTION 2-16 – COMPENSATION – OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADJUST THE COMPENSATION FOR MAYOR AND COUNCIL; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 36-35-4 of the Official Code of Georgia provides each municipal corporation of the state to fix the compensation of the governing authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.3 of the City’s Charter proscribes that the compensation of the Mayor and Council shall be established by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the compensation of the Mayor and Council has not been adjusted since Ordinance #07-02 on April 5, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the mayor and council desire to adjust the compensation to keep up with inflation and the cost of living in order to ensure adequate compensation to elected officials;

WHEREAS, said code section requires proper advertisement and notice of adjustments to said compensation and an election be held before said compensation adjustments take effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

That section 2-16 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Dublin, Georgia, which currently reads as follows:

“The salaries of the mayor and city council shall be as follows:

Mayor, nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) per month.

Council members, seven hundred dollars (\$700.00) per month.”

is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

“The compensation of the mayor and city council shall be as follows:

Mayor, One-Thousand Five-Hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) per month.

Council members, One-Thousand Two-Hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) per month.”

SECTION TWO

This ordinance shall become effective immediately after the taking of office of those elected at the next regular municipal election which is held following the date on which the action to increase the compensation is taken. Any and all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, or any prior

proceedings in conflict with this Ordinance this day will be and are repealed, and this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.

SO ORDAINED this 7th day of August, 2025 by a vote of (6) FOR and (0) AGAINST.
