A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL, TO AWARD A BID TO TOTAL EARTH SERVICES, LLC (TES) FOR THE WEST MARY STREET ROAD AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND THE WEST MOORE STREET ROAD AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT FOR SAID SERVICES; TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY FOR APPROVALS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROJECT; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City has solicited bids for the West Mary Street Road and Drainage Improvements Project (the "Division 1 Project"), funded by CDBG; and

WHEREAS, the City has solicited bids for the West Moore Street Road and Drainage Improvements Project (the "Division 2 Project"), collectively (the "Projects"); and

WHEREAS, Total Earth Services, LLC ("TES") submitted the low bid of \$1,177,787.68 for the Division 1 Project; and

WHEREAS, Total Earth Services, LLC ("TES") submitted the low bid of \$173,624.20 for the Division 2 Project; and

WHEREAS, the West Mary Street Road and Drainage Improvement is a Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") project; and

WHEREAS, the City will use CDBG funds to pay for Division 1 Project; and

WHEREAS, the City will use T-SPLOST funds to pay for Division 2 Project; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to empower the City Manager to approve change orders for the Division 1 and Division 2 Projects without the need for further action from the Mayor and Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the City to engage the services of TES for the Division 1 and Division 2 Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to empower the City Manager or his or her designee to execute and deliver any other documentation required for the fulfillment of the purposes of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL that upon approval and recommendation by the City Manager and City/Staff Attorney, as to its

form, the Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver an Agreement satisfactory to them as may be appropriate for the performance of the Projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to approve expenditures, including change orders, for the Projects without further authorization from the Mayor and Council and all actions in furtherance of the Projects are hereby ratified and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the recommendation of the City Manager, the Mayor is authorized to execute additions, deletions, modifications, change orders, or other specifications for the Projects without further authorization from Council.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that execution of the Agreement by the Mayor or any other modification of it shall be conclusive evidence of the approvals required herein and all actions of the City, its officers, staff, and employees in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the Agreement are hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
