

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA TO AUTHORIZE THE RENEWAL OF STATE MANDATED PTSD COVERAGE FOR FIRST RESPONDERS; TO AUTHORIZE THE HUMAN RESOURCES DIRECTOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS FOR THE SAME; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Public Entity of the City of Dublin, Georgia, ("City") is a current member of the Georgia Interlocal Risk Management Agency (hereafter GIRMA), an interlocal risk management agency formed pursuant to Chapter 80 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; and

WHEREAS, the City employs first responders and, as required by state law, must provide supplemental, illness-specific insurance coverage for post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) for them (the "Coverage"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and council wish to empower the City's Human Resources Director to secure the needed supplemental insurance coverage for said first responders, as defined by state law.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council:

1. The Human Resources Director, or his designee, of the City of Dublin is authorized to act on behalf of the City of Dublin to secure Coverage required by state law for the city's first responders and all who are mandated for coverage, consistent with the premium quote attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and fully incorporated herein, by executing the necessary documents to secure the Coverage;
2. The Human Resources Director of the City of Dublin, or his designee, is designated as the City of Dublin's representative to GIRMA for purposes of the Coverage;
3. The City Manager of the City of Dublin may change the City's representative by making a written request to Georgia Municipal Association, Inc., the Program Administrator for GIRMA;
4. That all actions of the City, its officers, staff, and employees in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the documents required for the Coverage is hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed.
5. This resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption.

SO RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dublin this 18th day of June 2026 by a vote of 4 to 0.
