A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA, BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL, TO APPROVE THE AWARD OF BIDS TO BRENNTAG MID-SOUTH, LLC; UNIVAR SOLUTIONS USA, LLC; and RIVERLAND TRADING, LLC FOR WATER TREATMENT CHEMICAL SUPPLIES; TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF DOCUMENTS FOR SAID SUPPLIES; TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY FOR APPROVALS OF EXPENDITURES; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids (BID #26-05-001) for pricing for one-year water treatment chemicals; and

WHEREAS, Brenntag Mid-South, LLC submitted a price of \$1,929.00/Ton; \$1.19/lb/Cylinder of Chlorine; Univar Solutions USA, LLC submitted a price of \$0.60/lb of Hydrofluorosilicic Acid; and Riverland Trading, LLC submitted a price of \$115.192/pail of Potassium Permanganate, (the "Bids"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to award the Bids and provide authority to finalize the same for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL that the Bids be awarded and the City Manager may approve such documents as are necessary and prudent to affect the award of said Bids and may approve the termination of any agreements or modifications of the same as may become necessary for the operations of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to approve expenditures as needed to provide the chemicals necessary for the City's operation without further authorization from the Mayor and Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the execution of documents by the City Manager shall be conclusive evidence of the approvals required herein, and all actions of the City, its officers, staff, and employees in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the Agreement are hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.

SO RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dublin this 18th day of June 2026 by a vote of 4 to 0.
