A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO AUTHORIZE AN APPLICATION TO THE GEORGIA MUNICIPAL ASSOCIATION FOR A SAFETY GRANT FOR THE CITY; TO ACCEPT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID GRANT; TO AUTHORIZE ADMINISTRATION OF THE GRANT IF AWARDED; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OR CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER CERTAIN DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin has prepared an application for up to \$20,000 in grant funds from the Georgia Municipal Association for the purpose of improving safety by the installation of cameras in city vehicles (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to authorize the application and accept the Grant and authorize the City Manager to approve terms and conditions for the acceptance and administration of the Grant if awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the City of Dublin to apply for and accept the Grant for the stated purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to authorize the Mayor or City Manager to execute and deliver all documents which are necessary, customary, and proper for the application, acceptance, and administration of said Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN that the Grant is hereby approved for application and, if awarded, the City Manager may approve and accept the terms and conditions therewith and administer the Grant as appropriate and in compliance with the terms of the Grant; that the City Manager is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City and execute and deliver the documents necessary for application and acceptance of the same, and the Mayor or City Manager are authorized to execute and deliver any other documents which are necessary, customary, and proper for the application and acceptance of the Grant and its administration, all acts in furtherance of the purposes of this Resolution being ratified and approved.
