

**RESOLUTION  
#24-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR THE CITY OF DUBLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY FOR APPROVALS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE VEHICLE; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City is in need of an unmarked vehicle for the purpose of undercover operations of the Dublin Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council wish to empower the City Manager to approve expenditures for the vehicle up to a set amount without the need for further action from the Mayor and Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the City to purchase said vehicle for the use of undercover operations by the Dublin Police Department.

**THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate for the purchase and emergency equipment modification of an undercover vehicle, and that upon his approval the Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver any documents required to effect the same on behalf of the city.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager is authorized to approve expenditures for the vehicle up to a budget of \$60,000 without further authorization from the Mayor and Council and all emergency equipment modifications of the vehicle are hereby ratified and approved.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that upon the recommendation of the City Manager, the Mayor is authorized to approve additions, deletions, modifications, change orders, or other specifications for the vehicle without further authorization from the Council.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that execution of the required documents to effect the purchase of the vehicle by the Mayor shall be conclusive evidence of the approvals required herein and all actions of the City, its officers, staff, and employees in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the purposes of this Resolution is hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
