

**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN TO ACCEPT AND APPROVE A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FROM THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE STREET, FLOOD, DRAINAGE, AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON W. MARY STREET; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER DOCUMENTS FOR THE GRANT; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dublin ("City") has applied for and received award notification for a 2024 Community Development Block Grant (the "Grant") from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs ("DCA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant is for the Street, Flood, Drainage, and Sidewalk Improvements on W. Mary Street, (the "Project"), and is in the amount of \$939,537.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to authorize the Mayor and city staff to execute and deliver all documents necessary for the acceptance, administration, and performance of the Grant and the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN** that the Grant is hereby accepted by the City and the Mayor may execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to fully accept the Grant, administer the Grant, and perform the Grant and the Project and that the City Manager, or his designee, may execute and deliver any and all documents in furtherance of the purpose of this Resolution. The foregoing authorization includes, but is not limited to, the City Treasurer setting up any and all accounting needed for the administration of the Grant and the City Manager and City Treasurer approving any and all draw down requests for reimbursement of expenses associated with the Project to be funded through the Grant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all acts by any official, employee, or agent of the City in furtherance of the purpose of this Resolution are hereby ratified and approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall have immediate effect upon adoption.
