A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL APPROVING A LANGUAGE ACCESS PLAN (LAP) FOR LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENT (LEP) PERSONS TO COMPLY WITH CERTAIN HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) REGULATIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin (the Recipient) in order to be in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Executive Order 13166, must take timely and reasonable steps to provide Limited English Proficient (LEP) person with meaningful access to programs and activities funded by the federal government and awarded by DCA; and

WHEREAS, The Recipient must provide and update every five (5) years a Language Access Plan (LAP) for LEP persons.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN hereby approve the updated Language Access Plan (LAP) for the purpose of administering these federally funded grants.
