

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA BY AND THROUGH ITS MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH BRIAN FELDER AND ASSOCIATES, LLC (“FELDER”) FOR THE REPAIR AND RENOVATION OF A CITY OF DUBLIN PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY; TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY FOR APPROVALS OF EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROJECT; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City has requested qualifications for professional planning and preliminary design services for the City of Dublin Public Works Facility located on East Madison Street Dublin, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, FELDER has provided a response to the said request; and

WHEREAS, FELDER and the City wish to formalized the terms of the services to be provided and enter into an agreement in substantially the form as set forth in Exhibit “A” to this Resolution (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it in the best interest of the City to enter into the Agreement.

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED that, subject to the final approval of the City Manager, the Agreement is hereby approved and adopted and the Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver the same or an agreement of substantially the same form, subject to any such changes, insertions, and omissions as may be approved by the City Manager. It is specifically the intent of this Resolution to provide further authority to the City Manager to finalize the rates charged for the services rendered in the Agreement. The execution of the Agreement or an agreement of substantially the same form as herein authorized will be conclusive evidence of any such approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all action of the City, its officers, and staff in connection with the execution, delivery, and performance of the Agreement and the purpose of this Resolution is hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed. Upon recommendation of the City Manager, the Mayor is further authorized to execute any other document in furtherance of the purposes of this Resolution and the Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager may approve additions, deletions, modifications, and change orders for additional services for the purpose of the Agreement and the Mayor may execute any addendums or contract amendments as may be required to affect the same without further authorization from the Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
