A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUBLIN, GEORGIA TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION FOR ONEGEORGIA HURRICANE DISASTER RELIEF EFFORT FUNDS; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the OneGeorgia Authority has established the Hurricane Disaster Relief Effort program to assist local communities in the efforts to rebuild communities and assist storm victims; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin strives to identify, prioritize, and address critical infrastructure needs affected by Hurricane Helene for residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking OneGeorgia Hurricane Disaster Relief Funds to rehabilitate a portion of its sanitary sewer collection system affected by Hurricane Helene in order to provide citizens with access to a reliable sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the sewer infrastructure rehabilitation will allow the City to eliminate the issues with the existing sanitary sewer that were exacerbated by the affect of Hurricane Helene; and

WHEREAS, the City is eligible for OneGeorgia financial assistance in accordance with all provisions of the OneGeorgia Hurricane Disaster Relief Effort program, including the Disaster Declaration map provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the City has received support for the proposed infrastructure project; and

WHEREAS, the City has established a level of financial participation outlined in the full application for financial assistance which will be submitted to DCA for review and recommendation to the OneGeorgia Authority Board; and

WHEREAS, the City currently owns, operates and maintains all public infrastructure and utility easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council that the City agrees to submit an application for OneGeorgia Hurricane Disaster Relief Effort

Funds to pay for the proposed sewer rehabilitation project, including associated engineering costs; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor or his designee is authorized and directed to act as the official representative of the City, to act in connection with the application and to be responsible for compliance with the applicable state requirements of the program and to provide such additional information as may be required; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement for grant writing and administration services and required engineering services relating to the application and subsequent grant (if funded) and to execute the application and other required documents on behalf of the City; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a true and dedicated commitment has been made to the successful completion of the above project.

SO RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dublin this 25th day of November, 2025 by a vote of 5 to 0.
